



**Announcement on Temporary suspension of all types of visa  
for foreign nationals from all countries visiting Myanmar**

1. With a view to further strengthening measures to prevent the COVID-19 pandemic, the Government of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar decided to adopt the following entry visa restrictions **for visitors from** with effect from *29 March 2020, 0001 hours* (Myanmar standard time) and temporary measures will be in force **till 30 April 2020**:

- (a) **Suspension of the issuance of all types of visa** (including social visas) **to all foreign nationals, except** diplomats accredited to Myanmar, United Nations officials resident in Myanmar and crew of ships operating to and from Myanmar.
- (b) **Suspension of visa exemption** granted to all foreign nationals on the basis of bilateral arrangements, including those from ASEAN countries, except those holding diplomatic and official passports.
- (c) All diplomats accredited to Myanmar and United Nations officials resident in Myanmar may obtain entry visas through Myanmar Missions abroad. They shall be required to provide a medical certification of the absence of COVID-19 infection issued by a recognized laboratory no more than 72 hours prior to the departure and before boarding any aircraft destined for Myanmar. They shall be **subject to home quarantine for 14 days on their arrival in Myanmar**.

- (d) Crew of ships or aircraft operating to and from Myanmar
