



“The Notification regarding the temporary travel restriction imposed on travelers coming from specific areas of Korea into the Republic of the Union of Myanmar with effect from 7 March 2020”

The Embassy of Myanmar informs that the following temporary travel restriction to Myanmar will be imposed to help curb the spread of COVID-19:

- (a) Temporary ban of entry into Myanmar for all foreigners who have travelled to Daegu and Gyeongbuk regions within (14) days immediately preceding their arrival in Myanmar.
- (b) Myanmar citizens coming from those areas in Korea would be quarantined and temporarily restricted to travel for (14) days starting from the entry date into the Republic of the Union of Myanmar.
- (c) Any person (including Myanmar citizens) entering the Republic of the Union of Myanmar are obliged to fill out the Health Declaration Form completely during the flights. Persons who refuse to fill out the form completely would be rejected to enter the country.
